20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-112 is amended to read as follows:
23 5-14-112. Indecent exposure.

24 (a) A person commits indecent exposure if, with purpose to arouse or
25 gratify the sexual desire of the person or of any other person, the person
26 exposes his or her sex organs:

27 (1) In a public place or public view; or

28 (2) Under circumstances in which the person knows the conduct is
29 likely to cause affront or alarm.

30 (b)(1) Indecent exposure is a Class A misdemeanor.

31 (2)(A) If the indecent exposure is committed against a person
32 under the age of fifteen (15) years, ~~but greater than eleven (11) years,~~ a
33 second or subsequent offense of indecent exposure against a person under the
34 age of fifteen (15) years, ~~but greater than eleven (11) years,~~ shall be a
35 Class D felony.

36 (B) Subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section shall not apply
