Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE OFFENSE OF SEXUAL ASSAULT IN THE FOURTH DEGREE TO INCLUDE SEXUAL CONTACT WITH A PERSON NOT THE PERSON'S SPOUSE WHO IS LESS THAN SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE OFFENSE OF SEXUAL ASSAULT IN THE FOURTH DEGREE TO INCLUDE SEXUAL CONTACT WITH A PERSON NOT THE PERSON'S SPOUSE WHO IS LESS THAN SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-127 is amended to read as follows:
5-14-127. Sexual assault in the fourth degree.
(a) (1) A person commits sexual assault in the fourth degree if, being twenty (20) years of age or older, the person engages in sexual intercourse, or deviate sexual activity, or sexual contact with another person, not the person's spouse, who is less than sixteen (16) years of age; or
(2) The person engages in sexual contact with another person, not the person's spouse, who is less than sixteen (16) years of age.
(3) It is an affirmative defense under this section that the person was not more than three (3) years older than the victim.
(b)(c)(l) Sexual assault in the fourth degree is a Class A misdemeanor. Class D felony.
(2) Sexual assault in the fourth degree is a Class A misdemeanor
if the person only engages in sexual contact with another person as described
