19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. (a)(1) If a defendant, who has not been previously
22 convicted of a felony, enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a
23 felony, the circuit judge, without entering a judgment of guilt and with the
24 consent of the defendant, may defer further proceedings and place the
25 defendant on probation for a period of not more than one (1) year on
26 condition that the accused successfully completes a boot camp program under
27 the direction of the Board of Correction.

28 (2) Upon violation of the condition of probation, the court may
29 enter a judgment of guilt and proceed as otherwise provided by law.

30 (b) Upon successfully completing the boot camp program, the circuit
31 judge may discharge the defendant and enter an appropriate order dismissing
32 the case.
