21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 14, Subchapter 1 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 16-14-110. Additional marriage license fee.

26 (a) All county clerks in this state shall charge an additional fee of
27 thirteen dollars (\$13.00) for each marriage license issued.

28 (b) The clerks shall transmit the moneys collected under this section
29 to the Treasurer of State who shall deposit it in The Domestic Peace Fund as
30 special revenues.

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 6, Subchapter 4 is amended
33 to add an additional section to read as follows:

34 19-6-487. Domestic Peace Fund.

35 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor
36 of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue fund to be



1 known as the "Domestic Peace Fund".

2 (b)(1)(A) All moneys collected under § 16-14-110 shall be deposited
3 into the State Treasury to the credit of the fund as special revenue.

4 (B) The moneys designated from § 26-52-107(b)(1)(C) shall
5 be deposited into the fund as special revenue.

6 (2) The fund shall also consist of any other revenues as may be
7 authorized by law.

8 (c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas Child Abuse/Rape/Domestic
9 Violence Commission as provided under The Domestic Peace Act.
