1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

5 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 10 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 12 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

14 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

16 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

17 <u>effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is</u>

18 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this

19 Act are provided due to the limited time frame the State must comply with the

20 <u>Arkansas Supreme Court ruling declaring that the education system in Arkansas</u>

21 <u>is neither equitable nor adequate, and that the Supreme Court ordered its</u>

22 stay effective only until January 1, 2004, and that in the event of an

23 extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act

24 beyond the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon

25 the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

26 <u>Therefore</u>, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

27 <u>necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and</u>

28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its

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29 passage and approval.
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30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 31 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor

32 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is

33 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

34 the veto.
