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3	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - NORTH HEIGHTS RECREATION CENTER. There is
4	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
5	Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
6	successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
7	(A) For the renovation and repair of the swimming pool at the North
8	Heights Recreation Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$350,000.
9	(B) For upgrading the sidewalks and building entrance at the North Heights
10	Recreation Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$5,000.
11	(C) For the replacement of the gym floor at the North Heights Recreation
12	Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$36,000.
13	(D) For upgrading the lights in the gym at the North Heights Recreation
14	Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$3,000.
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16	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - NORTH LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY CENTER. There is
17	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
18	Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
19	successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
20	(A) For the repair of the structural settling damage in the gym and
21	adjoining rooms at the North Little Rock Community Center, the sum of
22	\$36,000.
23	(B) For the renovation of men's fitness at the North Little Rock Community
24	Center, the sum of\$7,000.
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26	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - SHERMAN PARK RECREATION CENTER AND PARK.
27	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
28	- Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
29	successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
30	(A) For upgrading the ball field and replacement of the bleachers at the
31	Sherman Park Recreation Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$8,000.
32	(B) For upgrading the playground equipment at the Sherman Park Recreation
33	Center in North Little Rock, the sum of\$38,000.
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35	SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
36	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

- 1 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
- 2 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
- 3 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
- 4 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
- 5 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
- 6 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
- 7 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
- 8 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
- 9 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
- 10 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 11 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
- 12 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
- 13 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
- 14 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
- 15 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
- 16 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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- 18 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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- 27 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
- 31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
- 36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1	safety	shall	be	in	full	force	and	effect	from	and	after	July	1,	2003.
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
