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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27

28 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - RURAL AND VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN
29 GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
30 Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the
31 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
32 following:

33 (A) For state support to the Buckville Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
34 of.....\$5,000.

35 (B) For state support to the Fountain Lake Fire Department, the sum
36 of.....\$5,000.



1 (C) For state support to the Highway 70 West Volunteer Fire Department,
2 the sum of.....\$5,000.

3 (D) For state support to the Hot Springs Fire Department, the sum
4 of.....\$5,000.

5 (E) For state support to the Hot Springs Village Volunteer Fire
6 Department, the sum of.....\$5,000.

7 (F) For state support to the Jessieville Volunteer Fire Department, the
8 sum of.....\$5,000.

9 (G) For state support to the Lake Hamilton Volunteer Fire Department, the
10 sum of.....\$5,000.

11 (H) For state support to the Lonsdale Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
12 of\$5,000.

13 (I) For state support to the Morningstar Volunteer Fire Department, the
14 sum of\$5,000.

15 (J) For state support to the Mountain Pine Fire Department, the sum of
16\$5,000.

17 (K) For state support to the Piney Volunteer Fire Department, the sum of
18\$5,000.

19 (L) For state support to the Weyerhaeuser Fire Department, the sum of
20\$5,000.

22 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
23 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
24 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
25 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
26 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
27 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
28 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
29 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
30 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
31 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
32 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
33 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

34 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
35 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
36 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of

1 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
2 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
3 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
4 otherwise by law.

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6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
21 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
22 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
25 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
