1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING 2 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State 3 4 Treasurer and Auditor of State one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the 5 Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund to the Department of Community 6 Correction Fund Account to assist in financing Drug Court Programs. Of the 7 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) transferred by this section, the Department 8 of Community Correction shall allocate funding of five hundred thousand 9 dollars (\$500,000) each fiscal year of the 2003-05 biennium solely to finance 10 the operations of Drug Court Programs. 11 12 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRYFORWARD. 1	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
