21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Finance and Administration may
24 authorize payroll deductions and withholding from wages of state employees if
25 authorized in writing or by means of electronic signature by the employee.

26 (b) If the department authorizes payroll deductions under this
27 section, it shall promulgate regulations to implement this section including
28 specifying the types of voluntary payroll deductions allowed for state
29 employees and the procedures for obtaining and revoking the payroll
30 deductions.
31

32 SECTION 2. (a) For purposes of this section, "municipality" means a
33 city of the first class, a city of the second class, or an incorporated town.

34 (b) The chief executive officer of any municipality may, if approved
35 by the governing body of the municipality, authorize payroll deductions and
36 withholding from wages of municipal employees if authorized in writing or by



1 means of electronic signature by the employee.

2 (c) If the governing body of a municipality approves the action of the
3 chief executive officer under this section, it shall by ordinance specify the
4 types of voluntary payroll deductions allowed for municipal employees and the
5 procedures for obtaining and revoking the payroll deductions.

7 SECTION 3. (a) The county judge of any county may, if approved by the
8 quorum court, authorize payroll deductions and withholding from wages of
9 county employees if authorized in writing or by means of electronic signature
10 by the employee.

11 (b) If a quorum court approves the action of the county judge under
12 this section, it shall by ordinance specify the types of voluntary payroll
13 deductions allowed for county employees and the procedures for obtaining and
14 revoking the payroll deductions.
