6	section, the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police	
7	shall promptly destroy the fingerprint card of the applicant.	
8	(f) No person shall be eligible to receive or hold a license issued by	
9	the board if that person has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to, or been	
10	found guilty of any of the following offenses by any court in the State of

10	(2) No record, file, or document shall be removed from the
11	custody of the Department of Arkansas State Police.
12	(i) Any information made available to the affected applicant for
13	licensure, or the person whose license is subject to revocation shall be
14	information pertaining to that person only.
15	(j) Rights of privilege and confidentiality established herein shall
16	not extend to any document created for purposes other than this background
17	check.
18	(k) The board shall adopt the necessary rules and regulations to fully
19	implement the provisions of this section.
