22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-202(a), concerning the limitations on		
23	the use of motor vehicle horns, is amended to read as follows:		
24	(a)(l)(A) Every motor vehicle when operated upon a highway shall be		
25	equipped with a horn in good working order and capable of emitting sound		
26	audible under normal conditions from a distance of not less than two hundred		
27	feet (200').		
28	(B) No horn or other warning device shall emit an		
29	unreasonably loud or	nreasonably loud or harsh sound or a whistle.

31	necessary to ensure safe operation, give audible warning with his horn but
