20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-202(a), concerning the limitations on
23 the use of motor vehicle horns, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a)(1)(A) Every motor vehicle when operated upon a highway shall be
25 equipped with a horn in good working order and capable of emitting sound
26 audible under normal conditions from a distance of not less than two hundred
27 feet (200').

28 (B) No horn or other warning device shall emit an
29 unreasonably loud or harsh sound or a whistle.

30 (2) The driver of a motor vehicle shall, when reasonably
31 necessary to ensure safe operation, give audible warning with his horn but
32 shall not otherwise use the horn when upon a public street or highway.
