20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. (a)(1) If a defendant, who has not been previously  
23 convicted of a felony, enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a  
24 felony, the circuit judge, without entering a judgment of guilt and with the  
25 consent of the defendant, may defer further proceedings and place the  
26 defendant on probation for a period of not more than one (1) year on  
27 condition that the accused successfully completes a boot camp program under  
28 the direction of the Board of Correction.

29 (2) Upon violation of the condition of probation, the court may  
30 enter a judgment of guilt and proceed as otherwise provided by law.

31 (b) Upon successfully completing the boot camp program, the circuit  
32 judge may discharge the defendant and enter an appropriate order dismissing  
33 the case.
