15 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 23-88-306
16 PERTAINING TO RURAL RISK UNDERWRITING.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. *Arkansas Code § 23-88-306 is amended by adding an*
22 *additional subsection to read as follows:*

23 *(d)(1) The Insurance Commissioner shall assess all members two hundred*
24 *dollars (\$200) initially for the expenses of mailing fire department renewal*
25 *subscription notices and such amounts thereafter, on an annual basis, to meet*
26 *the costs of the mailings.*

27 *(2) This subsection expires on December 31, 2006.*
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29 SECTION 2. *EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the*
30 *General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that fire is one of the leading*
31 *causes of loss in the state, and that funding of fire departments is*
32 *essential to combat these losses. Therefore, an emergency is declared to*
33 *exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the*
34 *public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:*

35 *(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;*

36 *(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,*



1 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
2 bill; or

3 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
4 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
