23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 2-35-304(c)(1) is amended to read as			
24	follows:			
25	(c)(1) When per	titions containing the signatures of	twenty percent	
26	(20%) of the cattle or	wners and producers in the state, as	determined by the	
27	latest available agricultural census, are filed with the council requesting			
28	that the question of continuing the twenty-five cent (25¢) per head			
29	assessment be submitted to a vote of the cattle owners and producers, the			
30	council shall cause an election to be held within ninety (90) days after the			
31	filing of the petitions.

33	SECTION 2. Arka	ansas Code § 2-35-304 is amended by a	ıdding additional

35	(d) If the Beef Promotion and Research Act of 1985 and the

2	this state shall be reactivated the same as if the national program had never		
3	existed and in addition there is levied, without any election, an additional

5	collected as provided in § 2-35-305 and disposed of as provided in § 2-35-		
6	<u>308.</u>		
7	(e)(1) Within ninety (90) days after beginning the collection of the		
8	seventy-five cent (75¢) assessment, the Arkansas Beef Council shall cause an		
9	election to be held on the question of the levy of an assessment of seventy-		
10	five cents (75¢) per head on all cattle sold in the state.		
11	(2) The election shall be held in the manner prescribed in		
12	subsections (a) through (c) of this section.		
13	(f)(1) If a majority of the cattle owners and producers in the state		
14	voting at the election vote for the levy of the additional seventy-five cents		
15	(75¢) per head on cattle sold in the state, the assessment shall continue		
16	until either terminated by the council or until another election is held at		
17	which a majority of the cattle owners and producers in the state vote against		
18	such levy.		
19	(2) If a majority of the cattle owners and producers in the		
20	state voting at the election vote against the levy of the additional seventy-		
21	five cents (75¢) per head on cattle sold in the state, the assessment shall		
22	be discontinued and shall not be levied again unless and until the levy is		
23	thereafter approved at an election called by the council.
