18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-13-204 is amended to read as follows:
21 5-13-204. Aggravated assault.

22 (a) A person commits aggravated assault if ~~r~~:

23 (1) under ~~Under~~ circumstances manifesting extreme indifference
24 to the value of human life, he or she purposely engages in conduct that
25 creates a substantial danger of death or serious physical injury to another
26 person~~r~~; or

27 (2)(A) With the intent to threaten another person, and
28 manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, the person
29 brandishes a firearm toward another person.

30 (B) It is no defense to a prosecution for aggravated
31 assault under this subdivision (a)(2) that the person possessed a license to
32 carry a concealed handgun.

33 (b) Aggravated assault is a Class D felony.
