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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. (a)(1) The sheriff of any county housing prisoners held
22 subject to a pick-up order for contempt of court for failure to pay child
23 support shall cause to be prepared and submitted to the Director of the
24 Office of Child Support Enforcement documentation detailing the number of
25 jail beds occupied each day during the previous month by prisoners held
26 subject to a pick-up order for contempt of court for failure to pay child
27 support.

28 (2) The Division of Legislative Audit shall audit on a
29 quarterly basis a random sample of the documentation submitted by counties to
30 the Director of the Office of Child Support Enforcement to ensure the
31 accuracy of county reimbursement costs by the state.

32 (b) The Board of Correction shall adopt regulations under which the
33 Office of Child Support Enforcement shall reimburse any county, for
34 reasonable cost of housing an inmate held subject to a pick-up order for
35 contempt of court for failure to pay child support and the actual costs paid
36 for any emergency medical care for physical injury or illness of the inmate,



1 if the injury or illness is directly related to the incarceration and the
2 county is required by law to provide medical care for inmates in the jail.

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
