20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-203(d) as amended by Act 195 of 2001,
23 concerning campaign contribution limitations, is amended to read as follows:

24 (d)(1) However, an organized political party as defined in § 7-1-
25 101(16) may contribute up to two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) to
26 each of the party's candidates per election.

27 (2) For the purposes of this subsection (d), a candidate is
28 considered a party candidate when the candidate has filed to run for office
29 with any recognized political party.
