20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the direction of the Prosecution Coordination
23 Commission, a part-time Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, from any additional
24 personnel provided to the Prosecution Coordination Commission by the Eighty-
25 fourth General Assembly, shall be situated in Searcy County, within the
26 Twentieth Judicial District.
27

28 SECTION 2. (a) Searcy County shall continue to bear the
29 responsibility and expense of providing, at the county's expense through an
30 annual appropriation, the following, at sufficient levels for operation, but
31 not less than the amounts appropriated by ordinance in effect February 1,
32 2003, the cost of facilities, equipment, supplies, salaries, and benefits of
33 existing support staff, and other office expenses for the elected prosecuting
34 attorney and deputy prosecuting attorney, and any other line item
35 appropriation as approved in the 2003 county budget except for deputy
36 prosecuting attorney salary and benefits.
