Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

an act to require high schools to teach a course
IN CONSUMER AND FAMILY LIFE SCIENCE TO ALL HIGH

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE HIGH SCHOOLS TO TEACH A COURSE IN CONSUMER AND FAMILY LIFE

SCIENCE TO ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-16-133. Consumer Science.
(a)(1) Beginning with the 2004-2005 school year, no less than one (l) full semester of consumer and family life science shall be taught to each student before graduation from a public high school.
(2) The course in consumer and family life science shall include instruction regarding families, parenting, nutrition and basic life skills.
(b)(1) Each public school superintendent in this state shall certify to the Department of Education no later than June 1, 2005, and annually thereafter, whether the school is in compliance with this section.
(2) The Director of the Department of Education shall report to the co-chairs of the Legislative Council no later than July 1 of each year the identity of the schools that have:

> (A) Reported compliance with this section;
> (B) Reported noncompliance; and
