13 AN ACT TO ALLOW ELECTED LAW ENFORCEMENT  
14 OFFICERS TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202(a), concerning eligibility to  
21 carry a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows:

22 (a) Any certified or elected law enforcement officer may carry a  
23 concealed handgun if that officer:

24 (1) Is presently in the employ of a public law enforcement  
25 department, office, or agency; and

26 (2) Is authorized by the public law enforcement department,  
27 office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her  
28 duties; and

29 (3) Is not subject to any disciplinary action by the public law  
30 enforcement department, office, or agency; and

31 (4) Is carrying appropriate written identification issued by the  
32 public law enforcement department, office, or agency identifying him or her  
33 as a certified law enforcement officer; and

34 (5) Is not otherwise prohibited under state or federal law.
