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6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a continuing and		
8	pressing need for skilled technical workers by business and industry in		
9	Arkansas which makes it necessary to establish this Arkansas Technical		
10	Careers Student Loan Forgiveness Program to aid persons desiring to enter an		
11	educational program. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this		
12	act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
13	health, and safety shall become effective on:		
14	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
15	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
16	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
17	<pre>bill; or</pre>		
18	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
19	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
