15 AN ACT TO LIMIT THE DISTRIBUTION OF
16 GENERAL REVENUES.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. (a) For the 2004-2005 fiscal year the distribution of
24 "general revenues available for distribution", as defined in Arkansas Code
25 19-5-202(b)(2)(B)(iii), shall be limited to the amount distributed during the
26 fiscal year 2003-2004 plus ninety percent (90%) of the increase in "general
27 revenue available for distribution" in fiscal year 2004-2005 over fiscal year
28 2003-2004.

29 (b) The additional amount of general revenues which would have been
30 available for distribution without this limit, if any, in the 2004-2005
31 fiscal year shall be transferred by the Treasurer of State on June 30, 2005
32 from the General Revenue Fund Account to the Budget Reserve Fund.

33 (c) Beginning with the 2005-2006 fiscal year and each fiscal year
34 thereafter, the additional amount of general revenues to be transferred by
35 the Treasurer of State on each June 30 to the Budget Reserve Fund shall be
36 the percentage reflected below times the difference between the amount of the



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1 current year's "general revenues available for distribution" and the sum of
 2 the previous year's actual general revenue distribution and the amount that
 3 was transferred from the Budget Reserve Fund during the previous fiscal year:

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 16 (d) Beginning with the 2005-2006 fiscal year and each fiscal year
 17 thereafter, the distribution of "general revenues available for
 18 distribution", as defined in Arkansas Code 19-5-202(b)(2)(B)(iii), shall be
 19 limited for the fiscal year to the percent, as reflected below, of increase
 20 in "general revenue available for distribution" in the current fiscal year
 21 over the previous fiscal year plus the amount that is available in the Budget
 22 Reserve Fund:

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 36 SECTION 2. Budget Reserve Fund Created. (a) There is established on

1 the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State and the Chief
2 Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Budget Reserve Fund.

3 (b) The fund shall consist of those general revenues collected as set
4 out in this Act.

5 (c) Beginning in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006 and each fiscal
6 year thereafter, the Treasurer of State shall transfer one-twelfth of the
7 balance in the fund to the General Revenue Fund Account, there to be
8 distributed to the various funds and fund accounts and in such amounts as set
9 out in Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 4.
