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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this act, a
25 defendant who pleads guilty, nolo contendere, or is found guilty of a felony
26 involving violence enumerated in subsection (b) of this section and who has
27 previously plead guilty, nolo contendere, or been found guilty of two (2) or
28 more felonies involving violence enumerated in subsection (b) of this
29 section, and in each instance has been confined in the Department of
30 Correction, shall be sentenced to life imprisonment.

31 (b) For the purposes of this section, a felony involving violence
32 shall mean:

33 (1) Any of the following felonies:

34 (A) Murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102;

35 (B) Murder in the second degree, § 5-10-103;

36 (C) Kidnapping, § 5-11-102;



- 1 (D) Aggravated robbery, § 5-12-103;
- 2 (E) Rape, § 5-14-103;
- 3 (F) Battery in the first degree, § 5-13-201;
- 4 (G) Terroristic act, § 5-13-310;
- 5 (H) Sexual assault in the first degree, § 5-14-124;
- 6 (I) Sexual indecency with a child, § 5-14-110;
- 7 (J) Domestic battering in the first degree, § 5-26-303;
- 8 (K) Unlawful discharge of a firearm from a vehicle, § 5-

9 74-107;

10 (L) Criminal use of prohibited weapons, § 5-73-104,
11 involving activities making it a Class B felony; or

12 (M) A felony attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to
13 commit:

- 14 (i) Capital murder, § 5-10-101;
- 15 (ii) Murder in the first degree, § 5-10-102;
- 16 (iii) Murder in the second degree, § 5-10-103;
- 17 (iv) Kidnapping, § 5-11-102;
- 18 (v) Aggravated robbery, § 5-12-103;
- 19 (vi) Rape, § 5-14-103;
- 20 (vii) Battery in the first degree, § 5-13-201;
- 21 (viii) Domestic battering in the first degree, § 5-

22 26-303; or

23 (2) A conviction of a comparable felony involving violence from
24 another jurisdiction for which the defendant was sentenced and committed to a
25 term of years in a penal facility.

26 (c) The same procedures shall govern trials at which a sentence to
27 life imprisonment is sought under this section as are used for extended terms
28 of imprisonment under § 5-4-501.

29 (d) The determination of whether a felony conviction from another
30 jurisdiction is comparable to one of the enumerated felonies involving
31 violence under Arkansas criminal law shall lie within the discretion of the
32 trial judge at the time of sentencing.
