- 8 (B) However, the State of Arkansas and the Attorney
- 9 General shall be prohibited from recovering civil penalties under both
- 10 subdivisions (a)(2)(A) and (B) of this section.
- 11 (b) In any action brought pursuant to this section, the State of
  12 Arkansas shall be required to prove all essential elements of the cause of
  13 action, including damages, by a preponderance of the evidence.
- 14 (c) Any penalty shall be paid into the Treasury of the State of 15 Arkansas and credited to the Arkansas Medicaid Program Trust Fund.
- (d) Any caregiver against whom any civil judgment is entered as the result of a civil action brought or threatened to be brought under this section by the State of Arkansas through the Attorney General shall be required to pay to the Attorney General all reasonable expenses which the court determines have been necessarily incurred in the enforcement of this chapter.
- (e) A civil action under this section may not be brought more than
  three (3) years after the date on which the violation of this subchapter is
  committed.

- 26 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
- 27 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Adult Abuse Statute is in
- 28 immediate need of a revision to clarify an ambiguity in the law; and that the
- 29 provisions of this act are essential to successful operations and activities
- 30 of the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit and the Department of Human Services.
- 31 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
- 32 <u>necessary for the preservation of the public peace</u>, health, and safety shall
- 33 become effective on:
- 34 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- 35 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
- 36 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
