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1 (a) The department is established and authorized to represent the 2 State of Arkansas in the promotion and development of landing fields, 3 airports, hangars, and other aeronautical projects and to cooperate with and 4 secure the cooperation of the Federal Aviation Administration and any other 5 duly authorized federal agencies interested in the development of 6 aeronautics. 7 (b)(1) The department is authorized to accept title to or lease 8 agreements for an airplane from a state agency. 9 (2) The department is authorized to provide pilots, maintenance, 10 and storage for all airplanes used by a state agency. 11 SECTION 3.
