3	(3) With regard to individuals who may function as nurse aids,		
4	the date the individual became eligible for placement in the registry; and		
5	(4) With regard to individuals who are the subject of an		
6	allegation of abuse, neglect, or misappropriation of property:		
7	(A) Documentation of the department's investigation,		
8	including the nature of the allegation and the evidence that led the		
9	department to conclude that the allegation was founded or true;		
10	(B) The date of the hearing, if the individual chose to		
11	have one, and its outcome; and		
12	(C) A statement of the individual disputing the		
13	allegation, if the individual chooses to make one.		
14	(c) The combined central registry database shall be accessible to		
15	qualified entities by telephone.
