4	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that telephone rates have increased		
6	for Arkansas residents; that allowing telecommunications providers to

8	and allowing the Arkansas Public Service Commission to adjust the intrastate
