## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to authorize electronic monitoring of the ROOMS OF RESIDENTS IN LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ELECTRONIC MONITORING OF THE ROOMS OF RESIDENTS IN LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 10, Subchapter 2 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

20-10-235. Electronic monitoring.
(a) A resident, the guardian, or legal representative of a resident who wishes to conduct electronic monitoring shall request the long-term care facility to monitor the resident.
(2) The request shall be made on a form designed by the Office of Long-Term Care of the Department of Human Services.
(b) If another person is a resident in the same room, the person requesting monitoring shall obtain consent of the other resident or the resident's guardian or legal representative.
(c) The facility shall permit a resident, a resident's guardian, or legal representative to monitor the room of the resident through the use of electronic monitoring devices.
(d) Electronic monitoring conducted under this section shall be voluntary at the request of the resident, the resident's guardian, or legal

## representative.

(e) No facility may refuse to admit an individual or remove a resident from the facility because of a request to conduct monitoring.
