9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 27, CHAPTER
10 15 TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL SUBCHAPTER TO PROVIDE FOR
11 THE ISSUANCE OF A CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER SPECIAL
12 LICENSE PLATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 15, is amended to add an
23 additional subchapter to read as follows:

24 Subchapter 39 - Constitutional Officers License Plate

26 27-15-3901. Special license plates.

27 The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration is
28 directed and shall furnish each constitutional officer a Constitutional
29 Officer special license plate for their personal motor vehicles under this
30 subchapter.
31

32 27-15-3902. Constitutional Officers.

33 (a)(1) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
34 shall each year cause to be prepared seven (7) special license plates for the
35 Constitutional Officers.

36 (2) These license plates shall be numbered consecutively "1"



1 through "7".

2 (b)(1) Upon each of these license plates there shall appear the word
 3 "Constitutional Officer" in addition to the other identification information
 4 as the director shall determine.

5 (2) Each Constitutional Officer is entitled to the issuance of a
 6 special license plate for up to two (2) personal motor vehicles.

7 (c)(1) The license plate numbered "1" shall be reserved for the
 8 Governor.

9 (2) On or before January 15 of each odd-numbered year, the
 10 Governor shall furnish the director with a list of the names of the
 11 Constitutional Officers and each other officer shall furnish the Governor
 12 with the name of any other person who may display the special license plate.

13 (3)(A) The words "Governor" shall appear on license plate number
 14 "1";

15 (B) The words "Lieutenant Governor" shall appear on
 16 license plate number "2";

17 (C) The words "Attorney General" shall appear on license
 18 plate number "3";

19 (D) The words "Secretary of State" shall appear on license
 20 plate number "4";

21 (E) The words "Treasurer of State" shall appear on license
 22 plate number "5";

23 (F) The words "Auditor of State" shall appear on license
 24 plate number "6"; and

25 (G) The word "Commissioner of State Lands" shall appear on
 26 license plate number "7".

27 (d) A Constitutional Officer who desires to obtain special plates may
 28 obtain them by applying to the director upon forms to be provided by the
 29 director and by paying the taxes and fees that may be due.

 31 27-15-3903. Display prohibited.

32 (a) Any person who was issued a special license plate under authority
 33 of this subchapter and is no longer a Constitutional Officer, or any other
 34 person who may display a special Constitutional Officer license plate, shall
 35 be prohibited from displaying the special license plate on any motor vehicle.

36 (b) Any person who shall operate a motor vehicle displaying the

1 special license plate in violation of this section shall be guilty of a
2 misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor
3 more than one hundred dollars (\$100).
