## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE PURPOSE OF THE COUNTY COLLECTOR'S AUTOMATED FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>AN ACT CONCERNING THE PURPOSE OF THE<br>COUNTY COLLECTOR'S AUTOMATED FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-6-305(c), concerning the collector of revenue, is amended to read as follows:
(c)(1) Commissions received by the county collector shall be used by the county collector to offset administrative costs.
(2) (A) The county collector may set aside up to ten percent ( $10 \%$ ) of the gross commissions collected annually to be credited to the county collector's automation fund to operate the office of the county collector, for administrative costs, and to purchase, maintain, and operate an automated record-keeping system.
(B) The acquisition and update of software for the automated accounting and record-keeping system shall be a permitted use of these funds.
(3) Moneys deposited in this fund may accumulate and shall be appropriated and expended for the uses designated in this section by the quorum court at the direction of the county collector.
(d) All moneys not used by the collector to offset administrative costs or set aside into the county collector's automation fund shall be
prorated to the appropriate taxing entities.
