20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-21-213(a), concerning the licensing and
23 registration of radioactive materials, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) The agency shall provide by rule or regulation for general or
25 specific licensing of accelerator-produced material, by-product material,
26 source material, special nuclear material, or devices or equipment utilizing
27 such material.

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-21-213(c)(8), concerning the licensing
30 and registration of radioactive materials, is amended to read as follows:

31 (c)(8) Licenses issued by the agency:

32 (A) Shall be nontransferable;

33 (B) Shall be renewed every five (5) ~~years~~ to ten (10) years based
34 on risk factors as determined by the agency; and

35 (C) Shall expire ~~five (5) years after issuance or~~ at a time
36 specified by the agency; and
