## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN INTERIM STUDY OF MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY FOR DISABLED CHILDREN NOT DEPENDENT ON VENTILATORS; TO STUDY IMPROVEMENTS IN AVAILABILITY OF PRIVATE CARE NURSES TO FAMILIES IN NEED OF IN-HOME CARE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO STUDY DISABLED CHILDREN AND THEIR ACCESS TO PRIVATE DUTY NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The House and Senate Interim Committees on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor shall study the problems that Arkansas families face in gaining and retaining eligibility for Medicaid assistance for children who need continuous medical health care, but are not ventilator dependent.
(b) The study shall include, but not be limited to:
(l) The Medicaid eligibility criteria for disabled children who are not dependent on a ventilator;
(2) The need for increased numbers of and improved compensation for private duty nurses;
(3) The creation of a Private Duty Eligibility Committee within the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services to:
(A) Visit the homes of families with disabled children;



(B) Study the impact on families of coping with a disabled child or children in the home;
(C) Develop alternative approaches to caring for disabled children in the home; and
(D) Recommend changes in the eligibility and utilization review criteria and processes concerning in-home care for disabled children.
