19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 2005, the offices of treasurer  
22 and tax collector in Franklin County, Arkansas shall be combined into one (1)  
23 office.

24 (b)(1) At the 2004 general election, the electors of Franklin County  
25 shall elect one (1) person to serve as treasurer and tax collector.

26 (2) The person elected as treasurer and tax collector shall take  
27 office on January 1, 2005.

28 (c) The treasurer and tax collector in Franklin County shall give bond  
29 for the faithful performance of his or her duties as is provided by law.  
30

31 SECTION 2. The treasurer and the tax collector of Franklin County  
32 shall receive compensation as shall be determined by the quorum court of  
33 Franklin County within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed  
34 by the General Assembly, and shall hire deputies and have other allowances as  
35 prescribed by the quorum court.
