18	(A) The location of the facility, including latitude and		
19	longitude;		
20	(B) The owner's name, address, and telephone number;		
21	(C) The operator's name, address, and telephone number;		
22	(D) The days and hours of operation;		
23	(E) The materials to be collected;		
24	(F) The location at which the waste will be delivered for		
25	transfer or disposal;		
26	(G) The location at which recyclable materials will be		
27	delivered for processing and recycling;		
28	(H) A seven and five-tenths (7.5) minute topographic quad		
29	map as prepared according to the Unified Soil Classification System showing		
30	the location of the facility; and

10	(f)(1) Regional solid waste management districts shall survey each		
11	convenience center at least quarterly and if the survey identifies any		
12	violations of the district's regulations, the district shall:		
13	(A) Close the convenience center; and		
14	(B) Notify the Arkansas Department of Environmental		
15	Quality that the certification has been rescinded.		
16	(2)(A) A convenience center may request a new survey, at any		
17	time after a closure by the regional solid waste management district.		
18	(B) If the district finds that the center has returned to		
19	compliance with the district's regulations, the district shall immediately:		
20	(i) Rescind the closure; and		
21	(ii) Notify the Arkansas Department of Environmental		
22	Quality that the center has returned to compliance.		
23	(g) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may adopt		
24	rules and regulations to carry out the intent and purposes of and to ensure		
25	compliance with this section.
