Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to delegate authority to the arkansas STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO REGULATE THE TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVES OVER THE STATE HIGHWAYS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

> TO DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO REGULATE THE TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVES OVER THE STATE HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-37-203 is amended to read as follows:
27-37-203. Vehicles transporting explosives.
(a) Any person operating any vehicle transporting any explosive as a cargo or other dangerous articles upon a highway shall, at all times, comply with the provisions of requirements of the regulations promulgated under this section.
(b) The vehicle shall be marked or placarded on each side and the rear with the word "EXPLOSIVES" in letters not less than eight inches (8") high, or there shall be displayed on the rear of the vehicle a red flag not less than twenty-four inches (24") square marked with the word "DANGER" in white letters six inches ( $6^{\prime \prime}$ ) high.
(c) Every vehicle shall be equipped with not less than two (2) fire extinguishers filled and ready for immediate use and placed at a convenient point on the vehicle so used.

(d)(b) The State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to promulgate such additional regulations governing the transportation of explosives and other dangerous articles in vehicles upon the highways as it shall deem advisable for the protection of the public.
