5	(1) The specialized and hazardous nature of firefighting
6	requires that firefighters possess the requisite knowledge and demonstrate

15	(a)(1) After January 1, 2004, no person shall be hired as a full-time

17	one (1) year or for a cumulative time exceeding two thousand nine hundred
18	twelve (2,912) compensated hours, unless that person is certified as
19	completing the mandatory training requirements in subsection (c) of this
