# For An Act To Be Entitled <br> an act to allow retiring Judges to be regularly AVAILABLE FOR TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. 

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ALLOW RETIRING JUDGES TO BE REGULARLY AVAILABLE FOR TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENTS .

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) A retiring circuit judge who is eligible to receive retirement benefits from the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System, rather than retiring, may elect to be regularly available for temporary assignments to hear cases around the state.
(b) (l) Any circuit judge electing the option in subsection (a) of this section, upon appointment by the Supreme Court, shall not receive regular retirement benefits, but shall receive compensation equal to seventy-five percent ( $75 \%$ ) of the rate as fixed by law for regularly elected circuit judges to be paid from the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System.
(2) Any circuit judge electing the option in subsection (a) of this section shall not be entitled to a change in membership status, or to any increase, decrease, or other modification to his or her retirement benefits as a result of his or her temporary service after retirement, but shall receive the retirement benefits to which he or she became entitled upon retirement.
