26	imprisoned for no less than twenty-four hours and no more than one (1) year,			
27	except that the court may order public service in lieu of jail, and shall be			
28	fined not less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) and no more than one			
29	thousand dollars (\$1000).			
30	(3) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or is
