Arkansas Code § 11-10-314(k) is amended to read as follows: (k)(1) The four (4) five (5) state entities specified in subsection (j) of this section are strictly prohibited from making any disclosure or redisclosure of the confidential information which may be made available to them under the provisions of subsection (j) of this section.

9 (2) Any publication of employer data by these entities shall be 10 done in strict accordance with the rules used by the agency and as prescribed 11 by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor to 12 prevent the disclosure of individual employer information.

13 (3) The governmental agency or entity requesting any information
14 under subsection (j) of this section shall reimburse the Arkansas Employment
15 Security Department for any and all costs incurred by the agency in making
