24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. (a) The Arkansas Department of Health shall develop
27 guidelines for the clean up of former clandestine methamphetamine drug labs
28 by April 1, 2004.

29 (b) The guidelines shall be made available on the Arkansas Department
30 of Health internet web site and shall be available to law enforcement
31 officials and the public upon request.

32 (c) The guidelines shall be reviewed and updated annually.
