1	(1) Fourteen percent (14%) Seven percent (7%) of the revenues			
2	derived from this fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special			
3	revenues and credited to the Public Health Fund to be used exclusively for

5	(2) Sixty-six percent (66%) Thirty-three percent (33%) of the
