35	which includes any one election and the corresponding run-off election;

3	(i) Persons who reside outside the county in which

5	(ii) Persons in long-term care or residential			
6	facilities licensed by the state; and

8	(3)(A) Persons whose application would be valid through the nex			
9	two (2) regularly scheduled general elections for federal office, including			
10	any resulting runoff elections, if requested by the voter.			
11	(B) This shall include citizens of the United States			
12	temporarily residing outside the territorial limits of the United States and			
13	District of Columbia, and their spouses and dependents when residing with or

15	(b)(c) Any person may distribute blank applications for absentee

18	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-409(b), concerning the materials			
19	furnished to qualified voters, is amended to read as follows:			
20	(b) If the applicant is registered or is otherwise eligible to vote			
21	absentee, the county clerk shall deliver or mail to the applicant or deliver			
22	pursuant to subsections $(d)$ - $(f)$ of this section to the person who delivers			
23	the application to the office of the county clerk pursuant to § 7-5-403 the			
24	following materials:			
25	(1) An official ballot for each election named in the			
26	application;			
27	(2) Instructions for voting and returning the ballot to the			
28	county clerk;			
29	(3) $(A)$ A sealable ballot secrecy envelope on which there shall			
30	be written or printed the words: "Ballot Only"; and on which shall be printed			
31	a blank voter statement containing the following information:			
32	"I reside at the address indicated on my application. I have enclosed in the			
33	return envelope:			
34	(i) My ballot stub;			
35	(ii) My completed voter statement;			
36	(iii) A copy of a current and valid photo

I have enclosed my marked ballot in the Ballot Only envelope, which I will place in the Return 21 22 Envelope.
