17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-106(a)(1)(A), concerning runoff  
20 elections for county and municipal officers, is amended to read as follows:

21 (a)(1)(A) Whenever there are more than two (2) candidates for election  
22 to any county elected office, including the office of justice of the peace,  
23 or for any municipal office at any general election held in this state and no  
24 candidate for the municipal or county office receives a majority of the votes  
25 cast for the office, there shall be a runoff general election held in that  
26 county or municipality ~~three (3)~~ four (4) weeks following the date of the  
27 general election at which the names of the two (2) candidates receiving the  
28 highest number of votes, but not a majority, shall be placed on the ballot to  
29 be voted upon by the qualified electors of the county or the municipality, as  
30 the case may be.
