18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1, is amended
21 to add an additional section to read as follows:

22 6-17-116. Noninstructional duties.

23 (a)(1) Any teacher providing twenty-five (25) hours or more of direct
24 classroom instruction per week, or any student services program teacher
25 including, but not limited to, guidance counselors, and library media
26 specialists, who provide interactive student instruction throughout the day,
27 shall not be assigned noninstructional duty.

28 (2) Any such teacher assigned noninstructional duties shall
29 receive an hourly per diem rate for the duty time.

30 (b) For the purpose of this section, "noninstructional duty" means the
31 supervision of students before or after the instructional day begins or ends
32 for students or for the supervision of students during lunches, recesses, or
33 scheduled breaks.
