18	(b) This section does not authorize participation in traditional		
19	sporting events such as football, basketball, baseball, cheerleading,		
20	volleyball, soccer, track and field, tennis, or golf.

22	SECTION 4. Students authorized by this act to compete in individual		
23	interscholastic activities, shall be eligible for all awards and honors given		
24	during the competition.
