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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-701(c)(1), pertaining to duties of the
24 treasurer of a school district, is amended to read as follows:

25 (1) To receive and disburse funds of the school district.
26 Disbursements of such funds shall be made only upon warrants signed by the
27 president ~~and secretary~~ of the school district board of directors and
28 countersigned by the superintendent of schools of the district. As an
29 evidence of authority for disbursement of any funds, ~~he~~ the treasurer shall
30 have on hand approved invoices and payrolls, such payrolls to be in
31 conformance with written contracts on file in his office;
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33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-918(a), pertaining to issuing and
34 countersigning warrants, is amended to read as follows:

35 (a) It shall be the duty of the district superintendent of schools to
36 serve as ex officio financial secretary and to issue and countersign ~~all~~



1 warrants signed by the president of the school district board of directors.

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
