## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CLARIFY WHICH SCHOOL OFFICIALS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN AND COUNTERSIGN WARRANTS ISSUED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-701(c)(l), pertaining to duties of the treasurer of a school district, is amended to read as follows:
(1) To receive and disburse funds of the school district. Disbursements of such funds shall be made only upon warrants signed by the president and secretary of the school district board of directors and countersigned by the superintendent of schools of the district. As an evidence of authority for disbursement of any funds, he the treasurer shall have on hand approved invoices and payrolls, such payrolls to be in conformance with written contracts on file in his office;

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-918(a), pertaining to issuing and countersigning warrants, is amended to read as follows:
(a) It shall be the duty of the district superintendent of schools to serve as ex officio financial secretary and to issue and countersign all
warrants signed by the president of the school district board of directors.
