## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW AN AGENT OF A LICENSEE WHO SELLS
OR ISSUES CHECKS SEVEN (7) BUSINESS DAYS TO TRANSMIT THE CREDITS TO THE LICENSEE OR TO DEPOSIT THE MONEY INTO THE LICENSEE'S BANK ACCOUNT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ALLOW AN AGENT OF A LICENSEE WHO SELLS OR ISSUES CHECKS SEVEN (7) BUSINESS DAYS TO TRANSMIT THE CREDITS TO THE LICENSEE OR TO DEPOSIT THE MONEY

INTO THE LICENSEE'S BANK ACCOUNT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-41-110(c), concerning time limits for an agent transmitting credits to a licensee that sells or issues checks or depositing money into the licensee's bank account, is amended to read as follows:
(c) All money or credits received by an agent of a licensee from the sale or issuance of checks or for the purpose of transmission must be remitted to the licensee or deposited with a bank authorized to do business in this state for credit to an account of the licensee not later than the third seventh business day following its receipt. However:
(1) The requirement shall not apply if an agent has placed on deposit with the licensee an amount not less than the average of the aggregate face amount of checks issued by the licensee and sold by the agent
per day multiplied by the number of days in excess of three (3) seven (7) of the remittance period agreed to in a written agreement between the agent and licensee; and
(2) The requirement shall not apply to funds received from the sale of travelers' checks.
