25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-41-110(c), concerning time limits for an

27	depositing money into the licensee's bank account, is amended to read as

30	sale or issuance of checks or for the purpose of transmission must be		
31	remitted to the licensee or deposited with a bank authorized to do business
